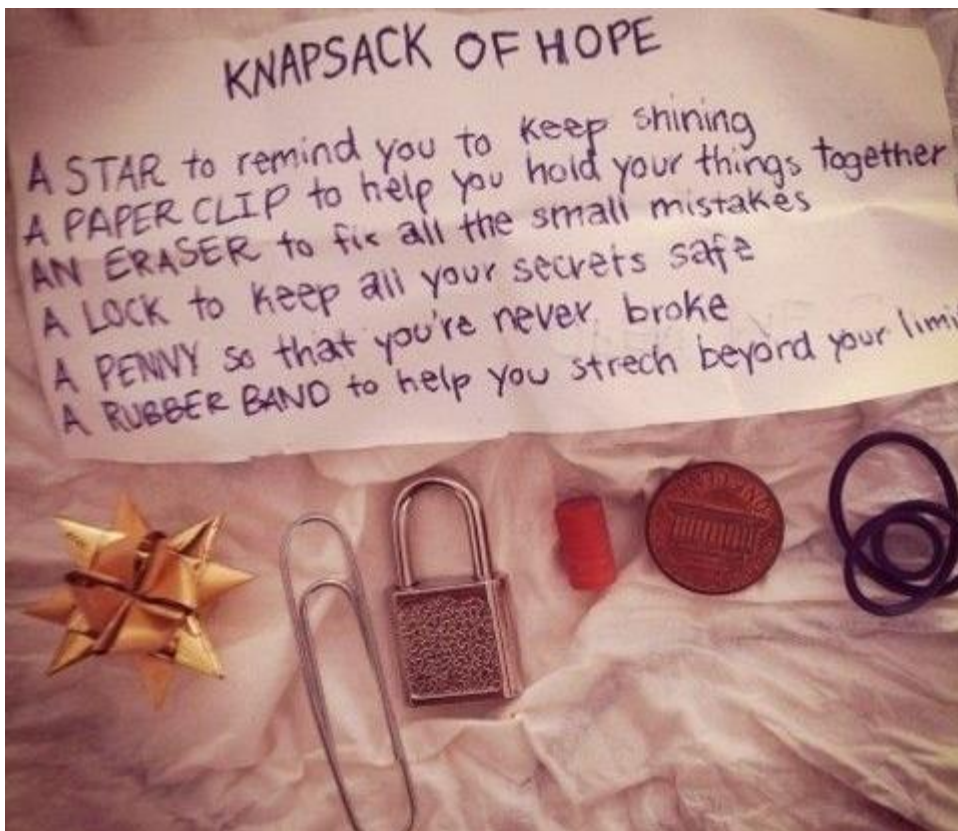

I want my boys to grow up to be confident men that treat all people, not just other men, with respect. Here's a small lesson on how to be a gentleman.

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her Ephesians 5:25

Husbands, love your wives and do not be harsh with them. Colossians 3:19

- Heroes will most likely grow up to be husbands. The Bible instructs men to love their wives sacrificially and be gentle with them.

- A simple act of kindness can go a long way. In this story, Jesus sits and chats with a Samaritan woman, strange not only because she's a woman, but also a Samaritan. But Jesus sees her as a child of God. He is kind, he doesn't judge her, he simply shows her love. And because of this, she went back to town and told people about Jesus, causing many of them to become Christ followers.
