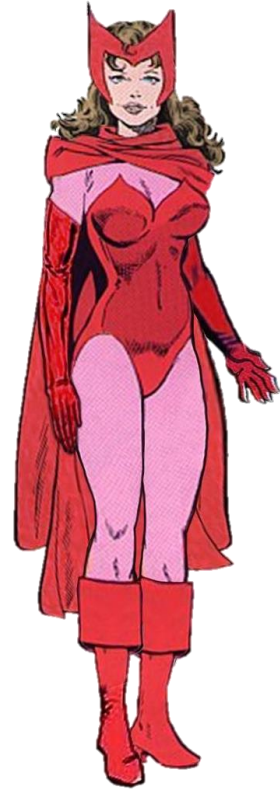


Summer Hero Training Scarlet Witch
