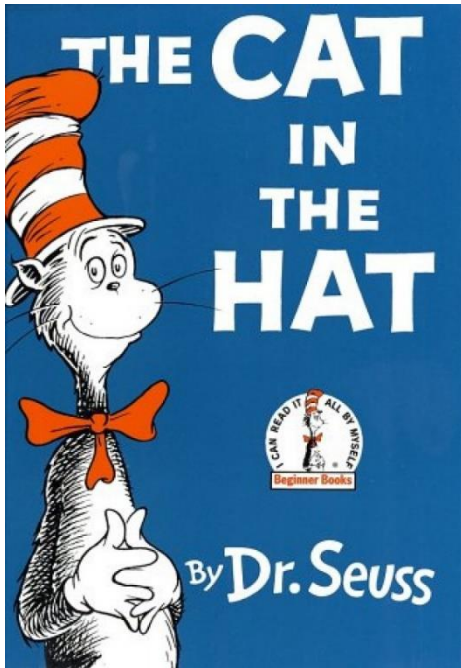

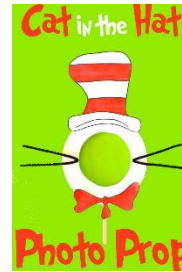
## Classic Dr. Seuss – Week One

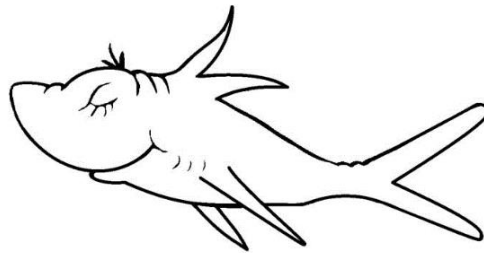


One Fish

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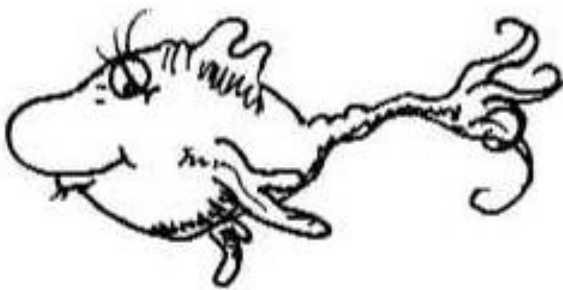
Two Fish

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Blue Fish

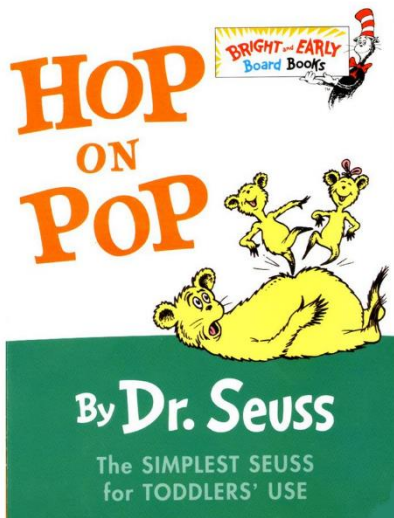

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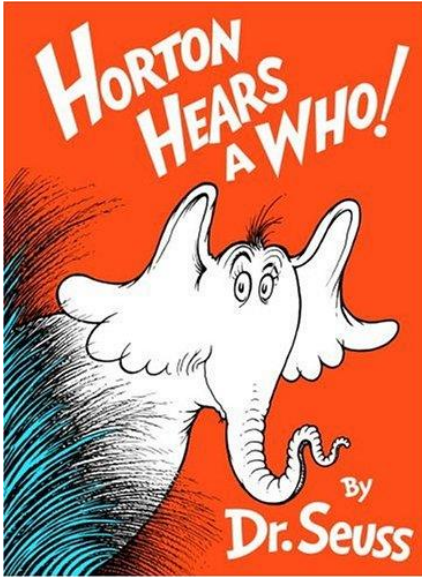

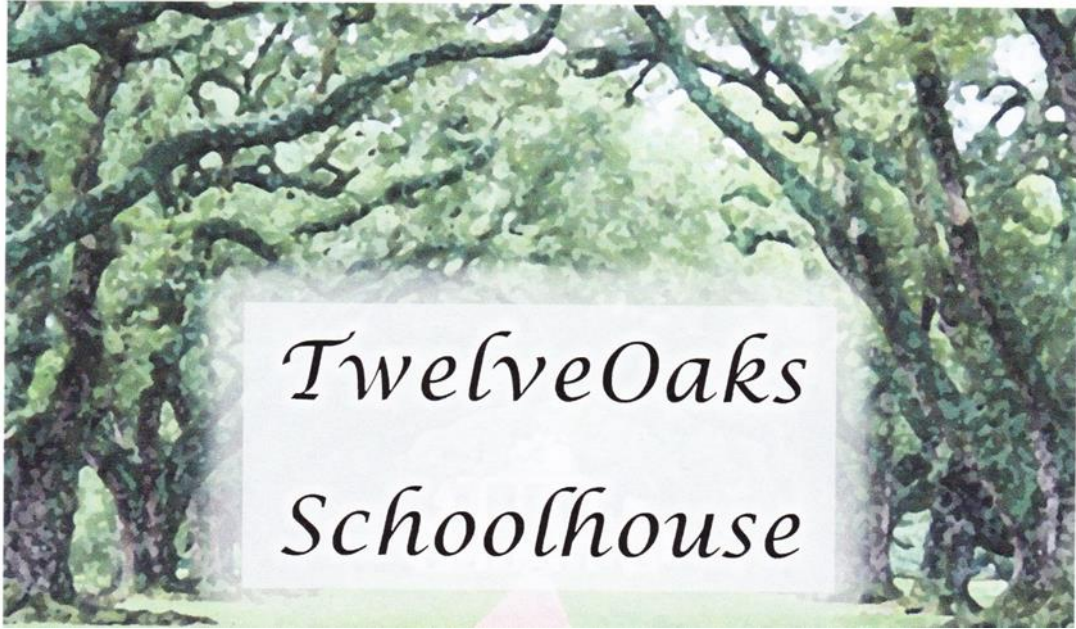
