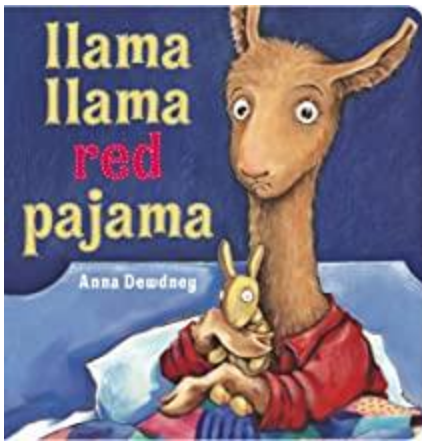

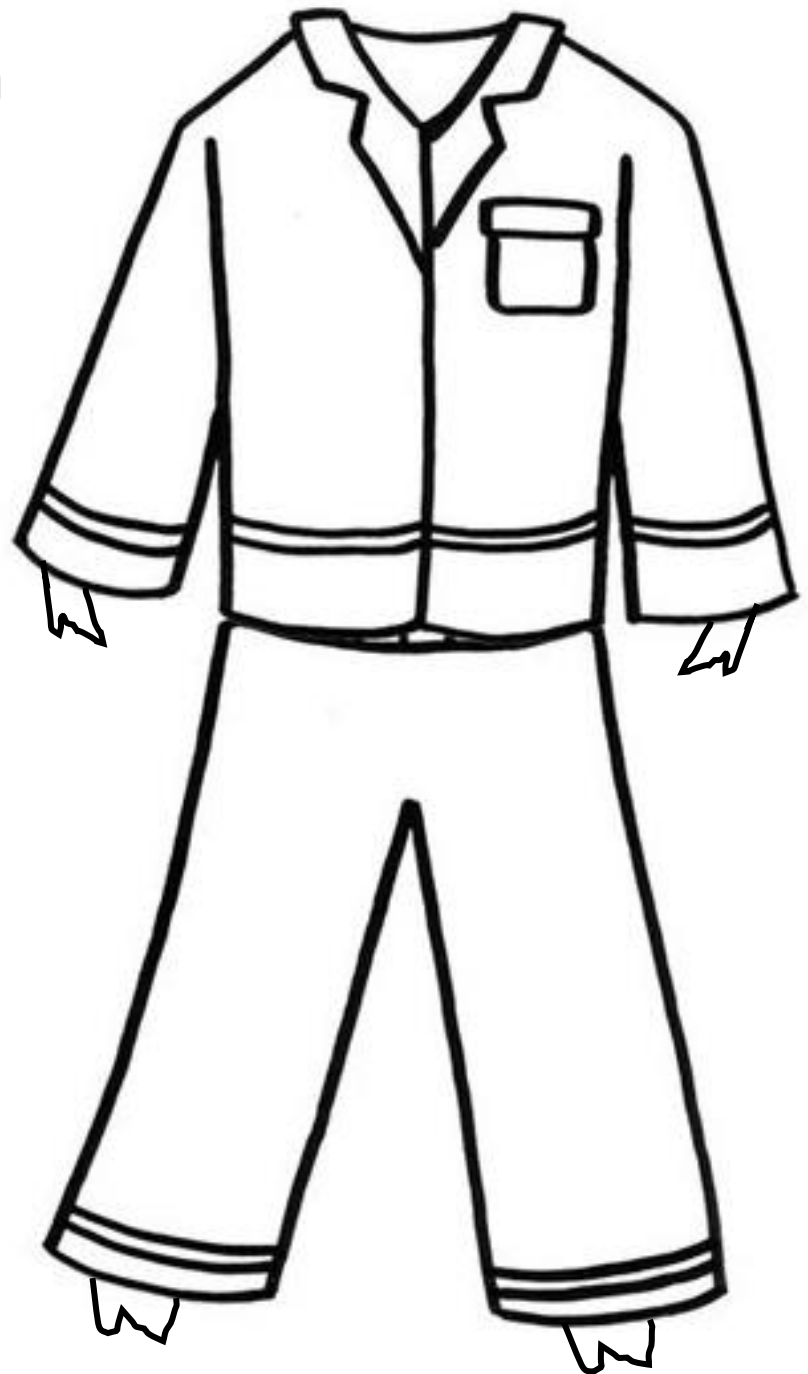
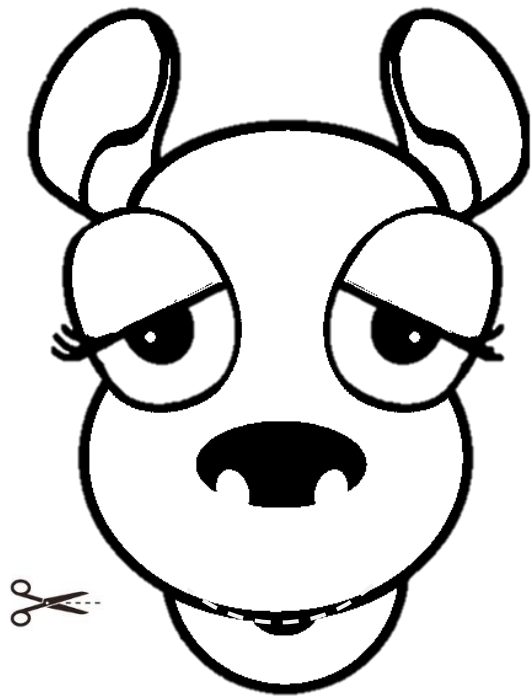

Print on cardstock, color and cut out. Paste pieces onto a lunch bag, placing the llama's mouth on the underside of the bag's bottom.

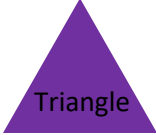
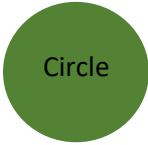


Llama Quilt Play-doh Mat

Print on card stock and laminate. Make squares of play-doh for each section of the quilt.








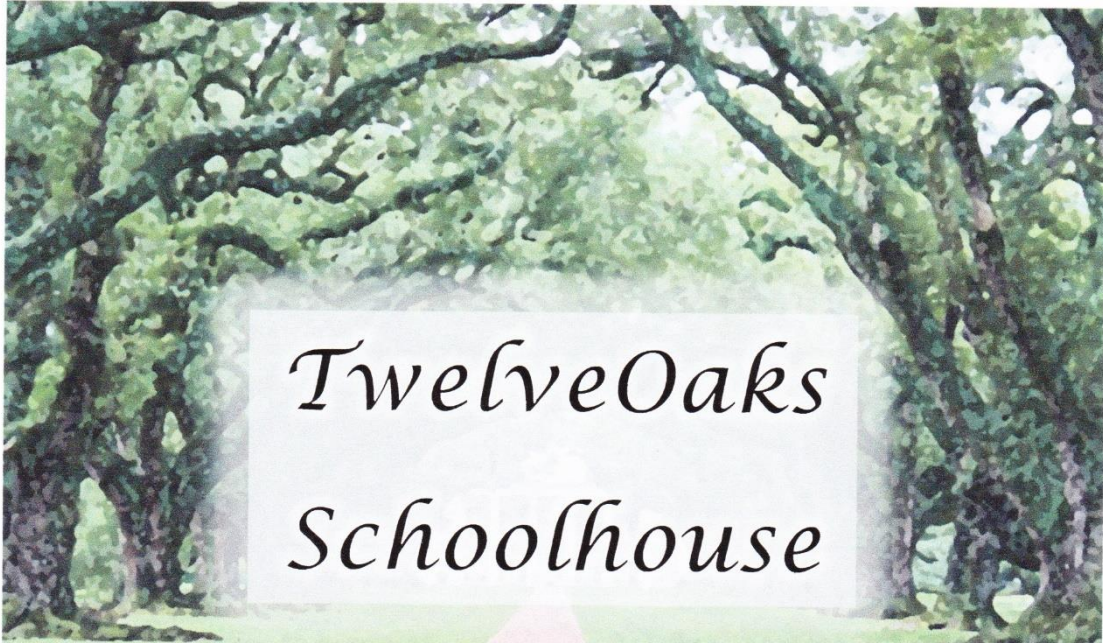
