



Story Elements - The Pied Piper of Hamelin




What is the main type of **Conflict** in the story? (circle one)

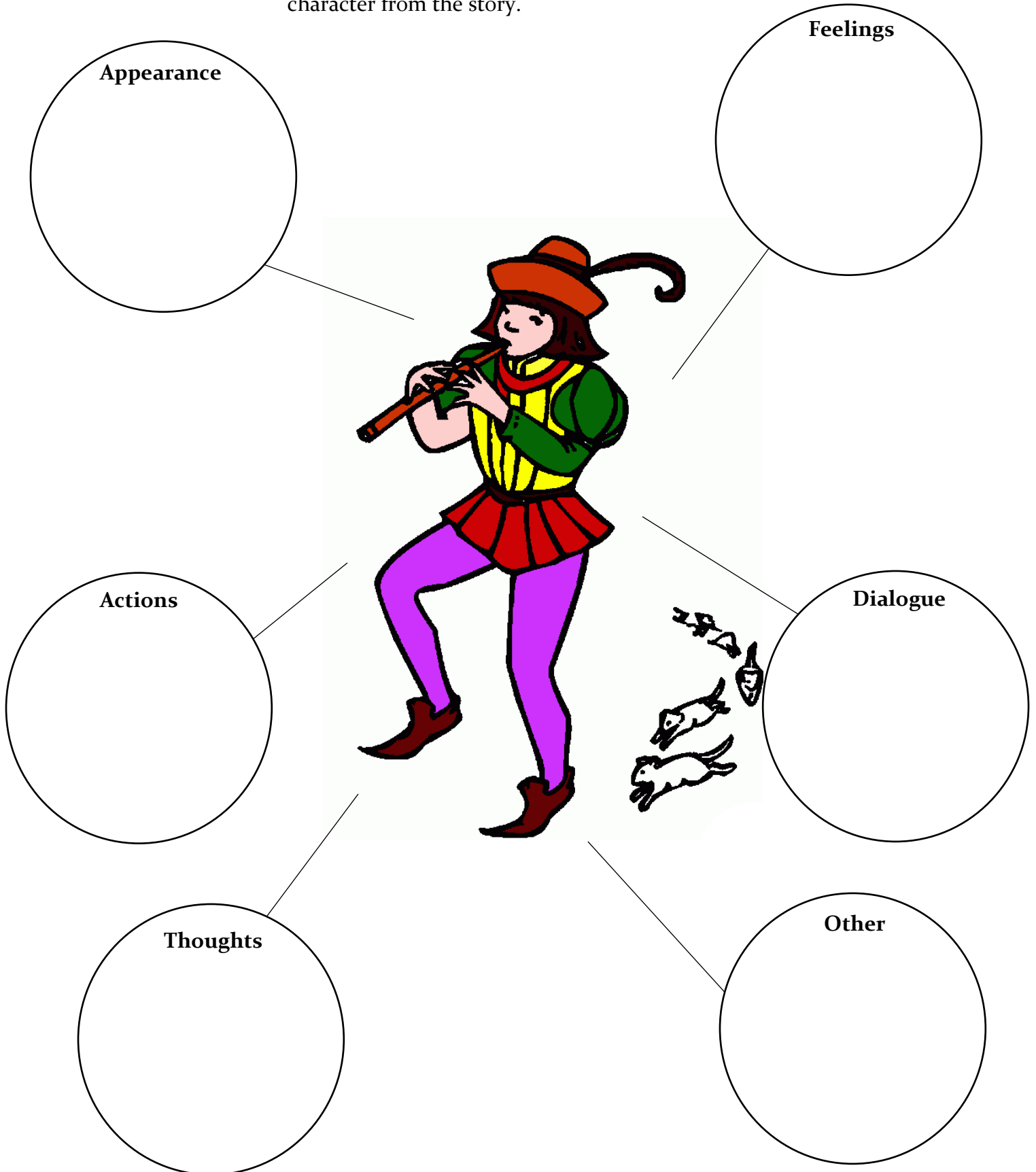

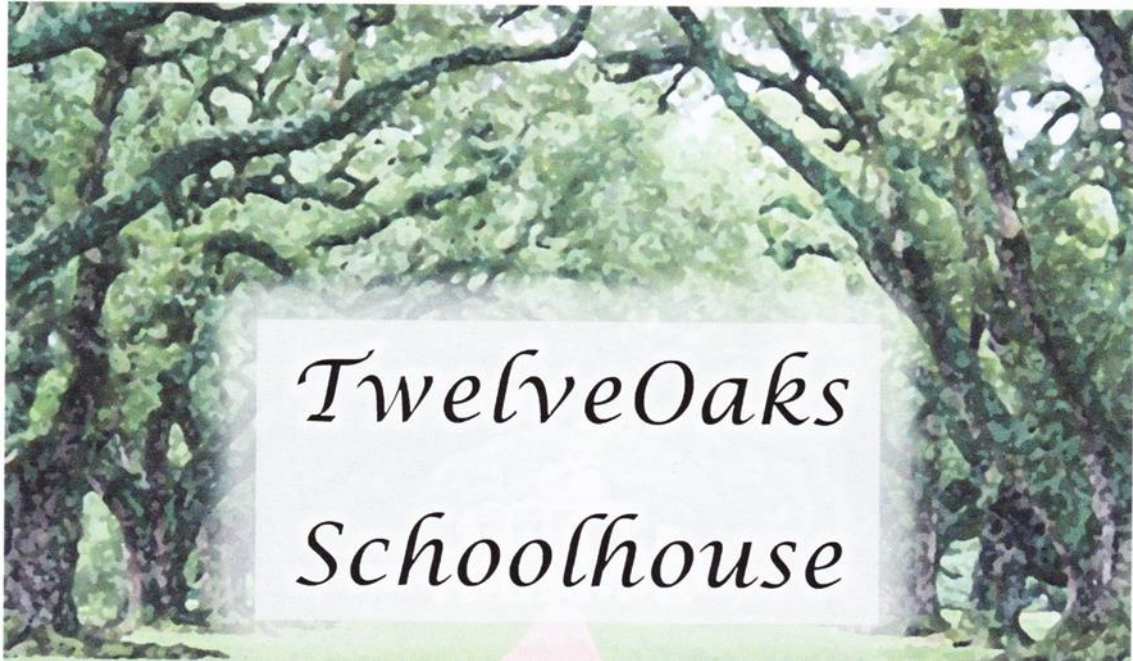
