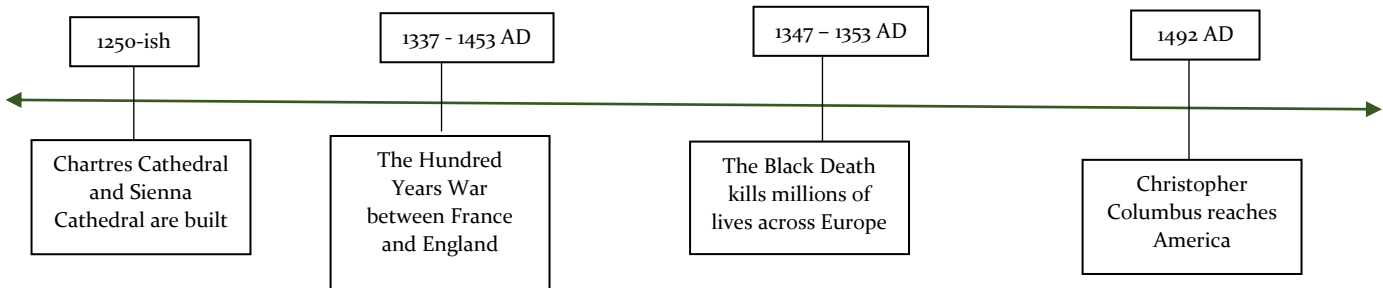
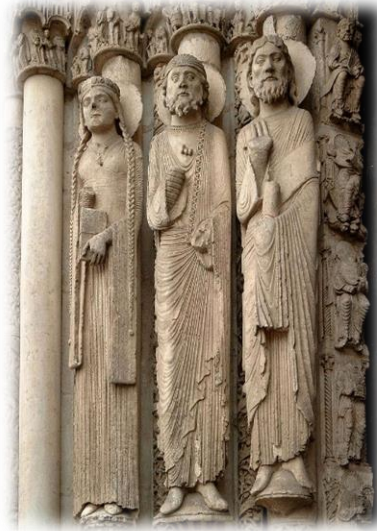


Gothic

The Gothic movement evolved from the Romanesque movement in the late 12th century and lasted until the end of the 16th century. Gothic art, though still greatly influenced by the Bible, were more detailed and gave a softer image of the biblical characters. Architecture in cathedrals grew taller with pointed arches and spires reaching to heaven. The earliest Gothic art was monumental sculpture of saints on the walls of churches.

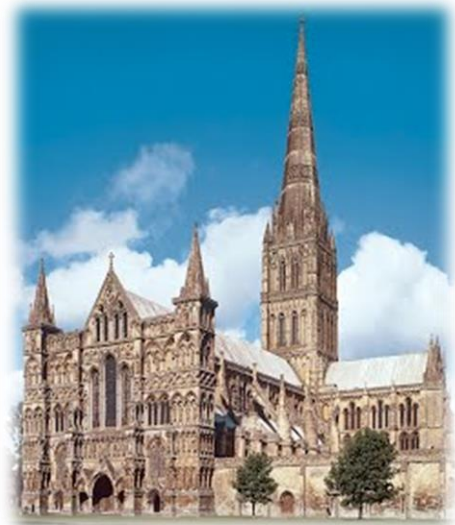

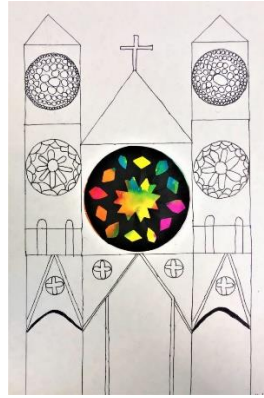

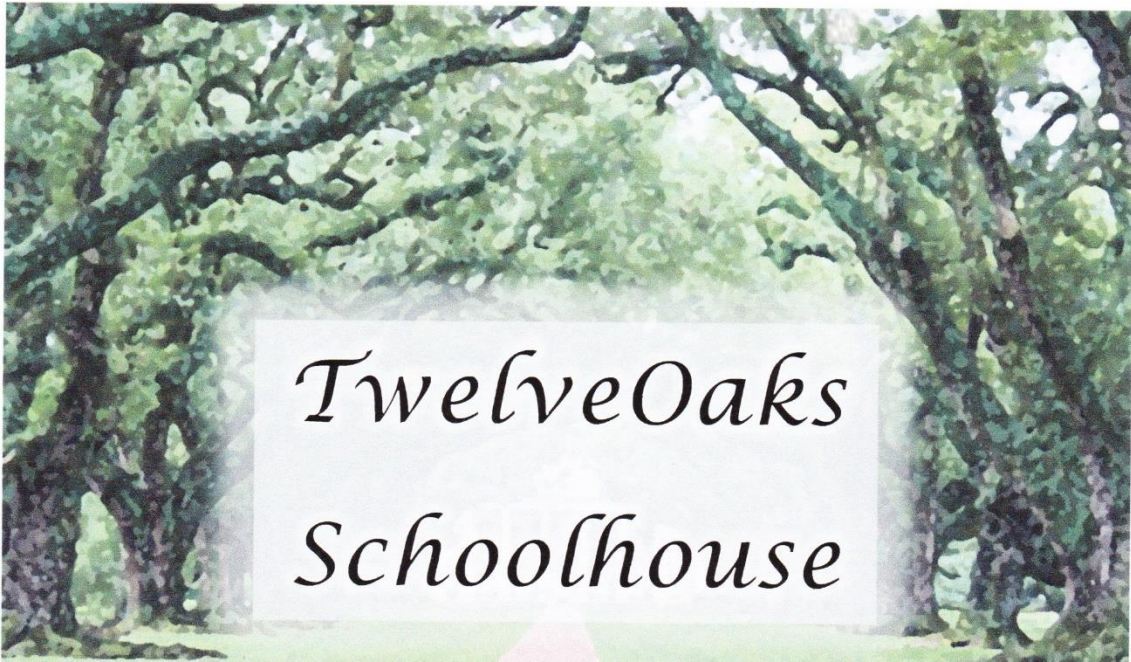
