Here is my handle, here is my spout


When I get all steamed up, here me shout

Wagging their tails behind them




(extra activity – hide cotton balls, or "sheep" around the room and have your child go on a sheep hunt)

Humpty Dumpty sat on a wall, Humpty Dumpty had a great fall. All the king's horses and all the king's men Couldn't put Humpty together again.




Hey diddle diddle, the cat and the fiddle The cow jumped over the moon The little dog laughed to see such fun And the dish ran away with the spoon!

1. Little Bo Peep found 2 sheep this morning and 1 sheep this afternoon. How many sheep did she find altogether?













2. Put Humpty Dumpty back together again. Which piece is missing?






3. How many king's men tried to help Humpty Dumpty? How many horses?
