Van Gogh lived in the Netherlands, England, Belgium and France

Interesting Fact: He suffered from severe mental illnesses and even cut off his own ear because he heard "voices" in that ear.







Van Gogh was inclined to immerse himself in local cultures and lighting conditions, although he maintained a highly individual visual outlook throughout.
