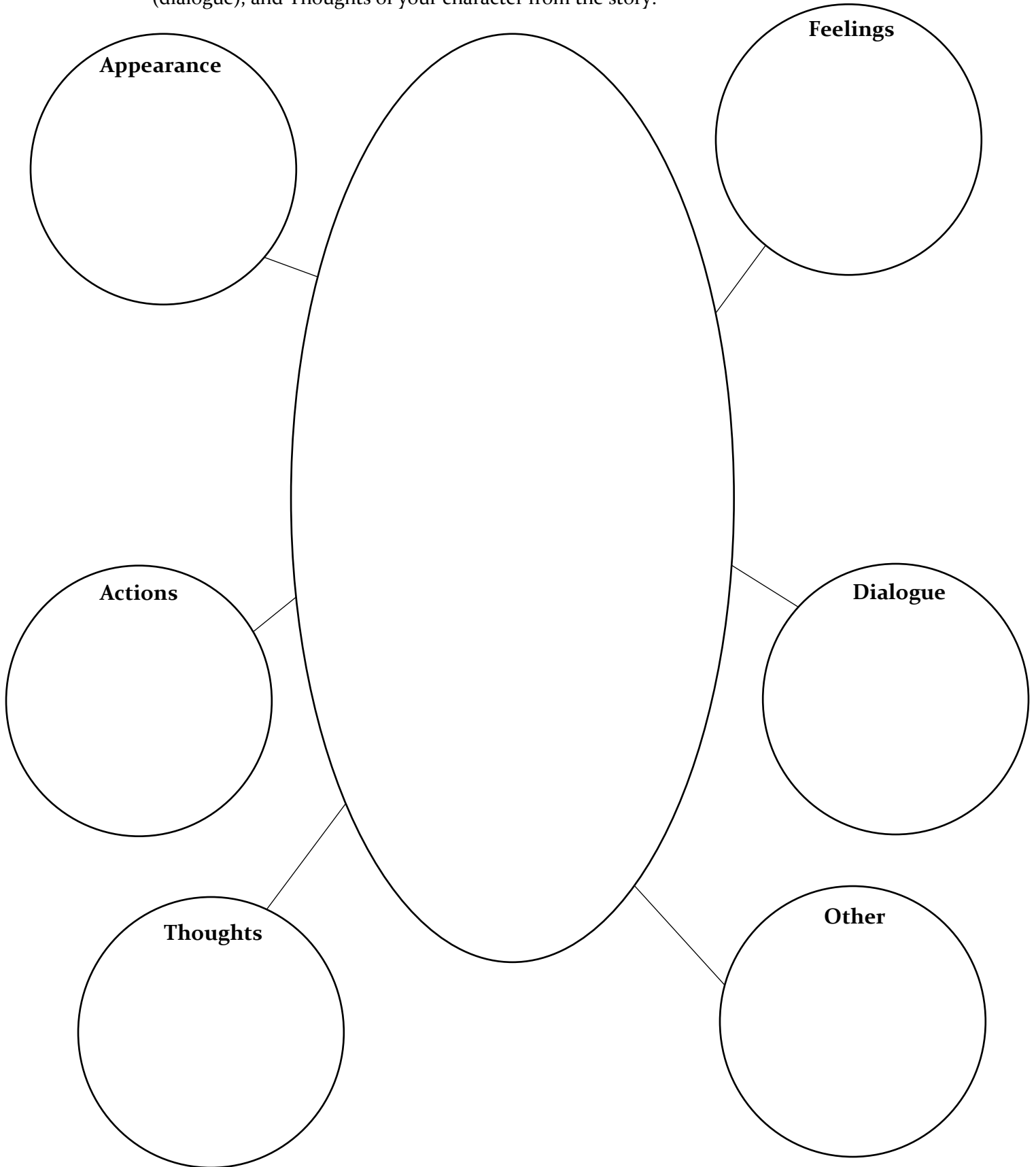


Puss in Boots

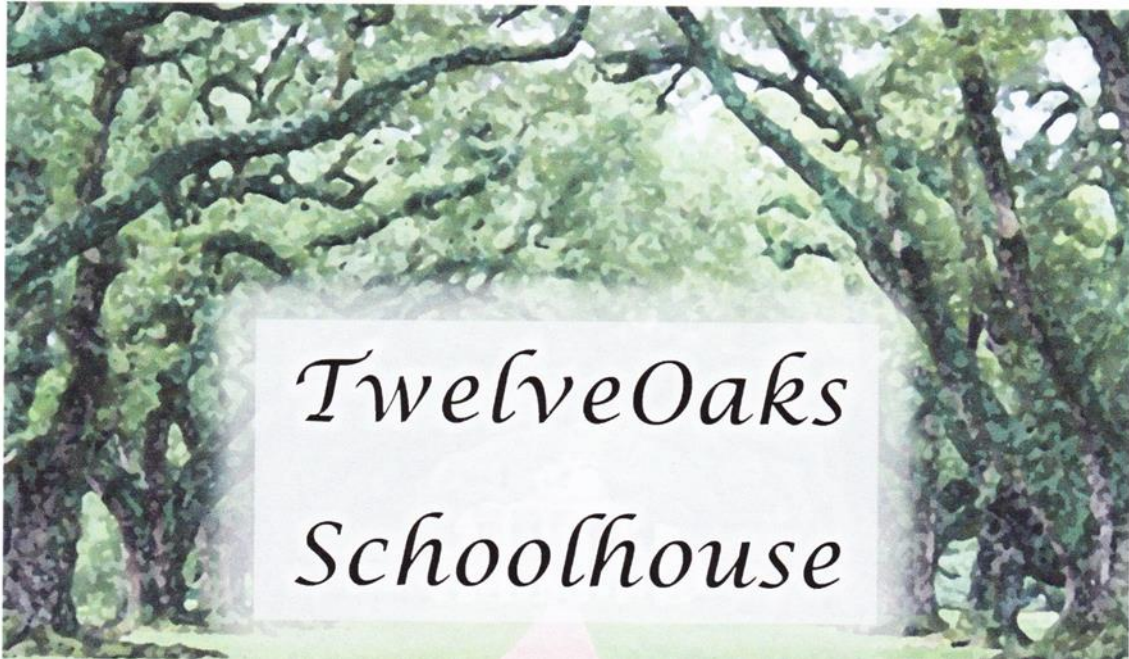
