

Lalla is a title in the Berber language meaning Lady or Miss. It is a polite form of addressing any woman used in Morocco, Algeria, Tunisia and Libya. Salma was granted the title Princess Lalla with the style of Royal Highness upon her marriage to King Mohammed VI in 2002. (photo on their wedding day)

Though once a prominent public figure worldwide, Lalla Salma has been rarely seen by media since 2017. Rumors flourish, most say she and the king are in the middle of a divorce.

Her son, Crown Prince Moulay Hassan is now 17 years old (born May 8, 2003) and her daughter, Princess Lalla Khadija is almost 14 (born February, 28, 2007).
