Born: July 16, 1907 near Mexico City

Died: July 13, 1954 (age 47)

Frida painted a lot of self-portraits.

Her paintings often had strong autobiographical elements and mixed realism with fantasy. Her long history of medical issues is portrayed in many of her paintings. Her husband, Diego Rivera was also an artist.
